## Standard Interconnection Supplement Generating Facilities with Rated Capacities Greater Than 10 kW

A Customer-Generator applicant ("Applicant") has made application to Lea County Electric Cooperative, Inc. (LCEC) to install and operate a generating facility with rated capacity greater than 10 kW interconnected with the LCEC utility system and certifies that:

The cooperative shall not be required to purchase and pay for any power in excess of 120% of the peak demand from the applicant. The facility shall not be constructed or designed to exceed 120% of peak demand usage. The inverter shall also be sized accordingly.

The cooperative shall install the metering necessary to determine the net metered energy delivered from the facility to the cooperative and from the cooperative to the facility for each billing period. The energy rate to be paid for the energy supplied by the facility in any month shall be the avoided cost rate filed with the New Mexico Public Regulation Commission and billing for any power from the cooperative will be at the cooperatives approved rate applicable to the service provided by the facility.

Applicant also certifies that, all actual cost of connection, switching, metering, transmission, distribution, safety provisions, legal fees and administrative costs along with any studies or engineering fees incurred by the Cooperative directly related to the installation and maintenance of the physical facilities necessary to permit interconnected operation with facility exclusive of any cost included in the calculation of the Avoided Cost, shall be borne by and be the responsibility of the facility.
