### Jackie C. Noack Memorial Scholarship

Jackie C. Noack was a respected lineman at Lea County Electric Cooperative, Inc. (LCEC) from 1968 until 1996. On August 8, 1996, Mr. Noack was killed in the line of duty serving the members of LCEC. On November 18, 1996, the Jackie C. Noack Memorial Scholarship was established at the request of his family to honor his memory. Since that date, 24 deserving students have benefited from this scholarship in pursuit of a higher education.

Scholarships are available in the amount of \$375 per semester and are renewable up to a maximum of four semesters (*excluding any summer or interim semesters*) with the total scholarship not to exceed \$1,500. This will be subject to confirmation that the requirements of grade point and enrollment have been met.

#### **Eligibility**

- 1. Available to active Lovington members receiving service from Lea County Electric Cooperative, Inc. and their dependents residing in service area.
- 2 Recipients must be a High School graduate or have successfully completed their GED requirements.
- 3. Scholarships may be used to attend any accredited United States university/college or trade school including on-line institutions of higher learning.
- 4. Applicant must be of good character as evidenced by two (2) letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a teacher, principal, counselor, etc., from the school applicant is currently attending. A second letter must be from either a member of the community (non-related) or applicant's peer. For applicants returning to school after an extended absence, letters will be accepted from previous employers, supervisors, ministers, etc. Letters of recommendation may be mailed directly to the Education Foundation or shall be included with this application.
- 5. Applicant must type a short biographical paragraph/background, including degree plan or area of study.
- 6. Applicant must demonstrate a coherent degree plan and willingness to pursue a course of higher learning.
- 7. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of funds available and the applicants' eligibility.
- 8. The deadline for the 2023 Application is Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 at the end of business day. Awards are generally announced on or before May 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.

#### Recipients

- 1. Recipient must maintain at least a 2.50 <u>cumulative</u> grade point average on a 4.00 scale and be considered a full-time student by the registrar at the institution to which scholarship funds are paid.
- 2. To demonstrate fulfillment of the requirements stated in Item 1 above, all recipients are responsible for ensuring that Lea County Electric Education Foundation receives an official transcript immediately following the end of each school <a href="mailto:semester">semester</a>. Funds cannot be released for the subsequent semester until an official transcript has been received and eligibility verified. Official transcripts must be received no later than June 15 for the preceding Spring semester, and by December 31 for the preceding Fall semester. Failure on the part of the recipient to ensure that an official transcript has been forwarded to the Education Foundation shall result in the forfeiture of the scholarship. Official transcripts must be requested of, and sent by, the college's registrar. Electronic transcripts shall be accepted.
